Tiki specialist. In this Express Tiki tutorial we will see together how to add a plugin wiki to a wiki page. Without further ado, let's start this tutorial.

Here I am on my Tiki on a wiki page, I am connected as any user who can edit a page and on this page I want to add a wiki plugin.

I click on the edit button, I position my cursor where I want to add my plugin wiki. I click on the little question mark icon. I click on the plugin help tab and I can discover the long list of plugin wiki that I can put on a page. I will insert a remark box. I click on the small icon and here I am in the dialog box which can allow to configure this wiki plugin. I will create a remark of the information type with the title Wiki plugin and the content how to add a wiki plugin I save. Here is the code of my wiki plugin and if I save my page I can see my wiki plugin inserted at the place where I chose it. The list of wiki plugins is very long and we will probably see that in another tutorial on Youtube.
